"Winecellars" Hercegkút - Malý Horeš SKHU/1902/1.1/051, in the Interreg V-A Slovakia-Hungary Cooperation Program, **Malý Horeš-Kisgéres** in Slovakia and Hercegkút in Hungary implemented joint tourism developments.

In Hercegkút, the two World Heritage-listed cellars are connected by a special wine tour route, and in the spirit of environmental awareness, visitors are transported by electric touring car. Tourists visiting the area can stay in the tourist house which has been modernized to create outstanding accommodation. Those arriving with electric cars can use the new car park and charging station installed there. During the wine tour, visitors are guided by a colourful map brochure so that everyone can easily find their way around the increasingly popular wine cellars. The former dirt road, which leads to the Kőporos cellars, has been resurfaced with a solid paved macadam road, providing convenient and fast transportation. A new maintenance machine will be purchased to take care of the cellars in Hercegkút, which are appearing more and more often in the press.

Within the framework of the cross-border tender program, wine tourism in Hercegkút and in Malý Horeš-Kisgéres can reach an even higher level of quality.

As a result of the improvements implemented at the locations of both projects, the number of day visitors and the number of overnight visitors staying in the villages is expected to increase. Also adding to the attractiveness of the area for visiting tourists are the large number of family wineries implementing their own quality improvements.
